

Tree Planting and Aftercare

Trees provide a multitude of benefits to society, both long and short term. Planting more trees has become increasingly important in the face of climate change and there is now a greater demand for people to plant these trees. This one-day course teaches you the basic principles of tree planting and aftercare

Join us for a morning of exploration and an afternoon of practical tree planting. No experience is necessary.

Who should attend?

This course is aimed at anyone who is interested in learning about effective tree planting and aftercare. This might include those currently employed considering employment in the industry, conservation volunteers or people with an interest in planting and establishing woodlands and trees.

Details of the course

In the first part of the day, we will explore the importance of trees and the different settings in which they are planted and managed. This will include understanding methods to plant that ensure successful establishment.

The second part of the day will be a practical session. Following a safety induction, all learners will be able to put into practice what they have learnt in the morning.

What will you learn?

By the end of the course learners will explore and understand:

- the importance of trees in the wider environment
- the basic physiological function of trees and factors affecting their growth
- the reasons for planting trees, various planting techniques and the right time to plant
- the importance of site preparation - using the right equipment, tree handling and storage
- how to protect newly planted trees against potential pests
- the importance of aftercare for newly planted trees and techniques
- the correct certification to undertake certain tasks, such as chemical spraying
- the importance of biosecurity when working with trees.

How will you benefit?

- Improve skill levels and environmental performance within your organisation or as an individual;
- Engage and motivate you or your team by enhancing their environmental knowledge.

What will you receive?

All delegates will be issued with a workbook, and certificate of attendance upon completion of this Tree Planting & Aftercare Course.

The course is delivered by Cora Pfarre, a professional Forester with many years of experience in the sector.

The facilities

This course is being held at Panshanger Park (near Hertford) Hertfordshire. SG14 2NA Panshanger Park is a grade II historic park and garden with landscapes designed by Humphry Repton and 'Capability' Brown. It is rich in history and woodland diversity which makes it the perfect place to study and practice tree planting and aftercare in the context of a woodland management plan.
